Project Warm Hearts Shoofly Block

Pattern beginning January 2025

9" finished block

Bright Fabric (any bright color):

Cut 2 - 3 1/8" squares Cut 1 - 3 1/2" square

White Background Fabric:

Cut 2 - 3 1/8" squares Cut 4 - 3 1/2" squares



Step 1:

Using the 2 bright and 2 white 3 %" squares, make 4 half square triangle blocks (HSTs). To make HSTs: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white squares. Pin a bright and a white square right sides together and stitch %" away from each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press toward the bright side. Trim to 3 %". Repeat with the other pair of bright and white squares.

Lay out the pieces to match the picture above.

Step 2:

Center row. Stitch a white 3 ½" square on one side of the bright 3 ½" square. Press toward the white square. Repeat on the other side. (Make 1 row.)



Step 3:

<u>Top and bottom rows</u>. Stitch a HST to a white 3 ½" square, taking care to orient the HST properly. Press toward white square. Repeat on the other side. (Make 2 rows.)



Step 4:

Stitch the 3 rows together, nesting the seams.

Press toward the center and trim to 9 ½", if necessary.
